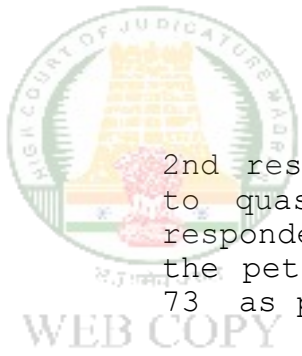

JUDGMENT

(Delivered by the Hon'ble Chief Justice)

However, looking to the nature of controversy, learned counsel for the appellants prays for withdrawal of this appeal with liberty to challenge the electricity connection provided to the writ petitioner by the respondent Board.
