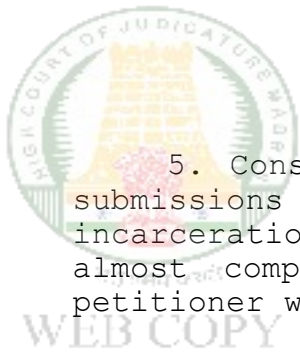
ORDER

The petitioner who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody for the offences under Section 341,294(b),324,392,397,506(2)of IPC r/w section 3 of TN Public Property(Prevention of Damages and Loss) Act in Crime No.303 of 2021,on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that petitioner along with other accused persons had assaulted and attacked the defacto complainant while he was working as a conductor in a private bus and also caused damage to the bus by breaking glass. Hence,the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case and that he has been suffering incarceration for many days. Hence, he would pray for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate(crl.side) raised objection stating that the petitioner along with other accused assaulted and attacked the defacto complainant and also caused damage to the bus by breaking glass. He further submits that the petitioner is having no previous cases and the investigation was almost completed.



5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made by both counsel and also considering the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner and the investigation was almost completed, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions;

(a) the Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing his own bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only), before the Superintendent of the concerned prison, in which the Petitioner has been confined and thereafter on his release;

(b) the petitioner shall execute two sureties for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Cuddalore within 15 days from the date of commencement of the Court's normal functioning, failing which the bail granted by this Court shall stand dismissed automatically;

(c) the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(d) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police on every Saturday at 10.30 a.m. until further orders;

(e) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(f) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(g) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and;

(h) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
