2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent, perused the materials available on record.

When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent reports that on receipt of the complaint, the respondent police conducted the investigation and registered a case in Crime No. 579 of 2021 and the petitioner has been arrayed as accused.

4. Under such circumstances, once the regular FIR has been registered, the question of "Not to harass" will not arise. Any direction issued by this Court at this stage will amount to



interfering with the investigation conducted by the respondent police.

5.Hence, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
