ORDER

When the matter is taken up today, the learned counsel appearing for the parties submitted that the parties have reached an amicable settlement and requested this Court to pass over the matter at 2.15 p.m. for recording the settlement in the presence of the parties.

2.When the matter is taken up at 2.15 p.m., the parties namely second plaintiff/Arutchelvi Kasinathan, second defendant/K.Sargunan and third defendant/Bhavani Rajendran are all present and they submitted that they settled the dispute between them and entered into a memorandum of compromise.
