Prayer : Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Declaration, declaring the order of dismissal bearing No.T.T.M.L.P.T./1061/2002(E) dated 26.06.2002 issued by the second respondent dismissing the petitioner from the service of the respondent Mills as illegal and unsustainable in law and void ab initio and consequently direct the respondents to restore the petitioner to service with continuity of service, full back wages and all consequential and attendant benefits.
