Subsequent to that, he was admitted in Coimbatore Hospital as inpatient and thereafter, he has not complied with the condition imposed.



4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) that the petitioner is complying with the condition, regularly, without any deviation, prior to his hospitalisation, the condition imposed on the petitioner to report before the respondent police, is relaxed.
