There is a delay of 288 days in filing the writ appeal.

2. Though the petitioners have explained the reasons for the delay, the same cannot be accepted in toto in the interests of justice. We are of the view that the delay can be condoned on payment of cost.

3. Mr. S.N. Ravichandran, learned counsel appearing for the respondent vehemently argued that the petitioners have not explained the reasons in a proper manner.

4. As already stated, the delay of 288 days can be condoned on payment of cost of Rs. 1,000/-. Accordingly, the delay of 288 days in filing the writ appeal is condoned on condition the petitioners paying a sum of Rs.1,000/- to the Chief Justice Relief Fund within a period of one (1) week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. In the event of petitioners not paying the cost amount within the time stipulated, the petition shall stand dismissed automatically.
