2.It is reported that offence of land grabbing by forging the document is under investigation.

3.The learned Additional Government Pleader states that the accused persons are not co-operating for the investigation.

4.Considering the gravity of the offence, this Criminal Original Petition for anticipatory bail is dismissed. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is also dismissed.
