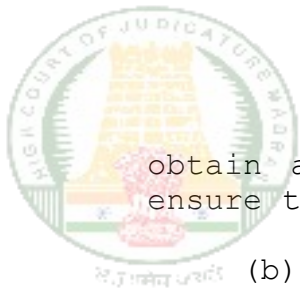

### ORDER

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 341, 294(b), 353, 332, 323, 324 and 307 of IPC, in Crime No.20 of 2022, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to wordy quarrel, the petitioners abused the defacto complainant with filthy language and assaulted the defacto complainant with wooden log. Thereby, the





obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b) the petitioners/A2, A3, A4, A6, A7 and A9 shall report before the respondent police every Monday and Saturday at 10.30 a.m., for a period of four weeks and thereafter as and when required for an interrogation;

(c) the petitioners/A2, A3, A4, A6, A7 and A9 shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d) the petitioners/A2, A3, A4, A6, A7 and A9, shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners/A2, A3, A4, A6, A7 and A9. in accordance with law as if the conditions has been imposed and the petitioners/A2, A3, A4, A6, A7 and A9 released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]***; and;

(f) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
