



5. The averments found in the First Information Report and the submissions made by the learned Government Advocate (crl.side) disclosed the fact that during the relevant point of time the petitioner and others joined together and after publishing the advertisement for calling for application to the post in Indian Government, they looted a money to the tune of nearly Rs.1.5 crores and as of now, the prime accused is not arrested. Apart from that, in many incidents the petitioner and others conducted bogus interview and exploited in many districts. Hence, considering the gravity of offence, this court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
