O R D E R

(Order of the Court made by M.DURAI SWAMY, J.)

The petitioner has filed the above Writ Petition to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to settle the two housing loan dispute in a peaceful manner by adjusting the Life Insurance Policy of her husband towards the said housing loan amounts and close the two LIC loan accounts and by waiving the balance loan amount fully as a special case under humanitarian grounds.

2. On a reading of the affidavit filed in support of the Writ Petition, it is clear that the petitioner's husband had committed suicide. When the petitioner's husband had committed suicide, whether the petitioner is entitled to get the LIC policy amount can be decided only by Life Insurance Corporation of India. When the petitioner has got no legal right to adjust the policy amount with the LIC Housing loans, the prayer sought for in the Writ Petition cannot be granted.

3. In such view of the matter, we are not inclined to entertain the Writ Petition. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is dismissed.No costs. Consequently the connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
