3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that the first petitioner is in coma stage and the second petitioner is complying with the condition without any deviation.



4. Accordingly, in view of the above said facts, this Court is inclined to allow this petition. Hence, this petition is allowed and the condition imposed on the petitioners to report before the respondent police, is relaxed.
