PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest for the alleged offences under section 294(b), 324, 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No.21 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that there arose wordy quarrel between the petitioner and the defacto complainant regarding drawing water from the canal. In which, the petitioner assaulted the defacto complainant resulted in simple injuries. Hence the complaint was registered by the Law Enforcing Agency.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any such offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that he has been falsely implicated in this case and the defacto complainant sustained only simple injuries. Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent submits that the injured person has been discharged from the hospital. However, he opposed grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
