Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus to call for the records relating to the impugned order of the second respondent in Na.Ka.No.47/2009/B5 dated 25.05.2010 and quash the same and direct the second respondent to include the petitioner name in the list of eligible Gang Mazdoors for promotion to the post of Road Inspector Grade-II issued by the second respondent in Memo No.47/2008/B3 dated 16.09.2008 at the appropriate place with reference to the date of regularisation in the post of Gang Mazdoor and promote him as Road Inspector Grade-II with effect from the date of promotion of his immediate junior, the third respondent herein and grant him all consequential benefits.
