2. That the award and decree dated 23.07.2019 passed in MCOP.No.161 of 2010, on the file of MACT Iind Judge,II Court of Small Causes Chennai insofar as the fixating liability on the Appellant herein/2nd Respondent Insurance Company concerned be and hereby is setaside.

3. That the 3rd Respondent herein/1st Respondent owner of the vehicle be and hereby is liable to pay the compensation awarded by the Tribunal together with interest at 7.5% per annum from the date of the claim petition till the date of realization.

4. That there be no costs in this Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.
