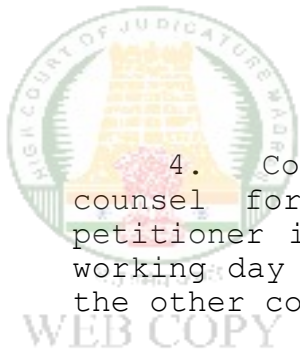

This is a petition to relax the condition.

2. The condition now in force is that the petitioner shall have to appear before the trial Court on the first working day of every month at 10.30 am.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was suspended from service and he finds it difficult to comply with the condition especially in the prevailing covid 19 pandemic situation.



4. Considering the reasons and submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the condition is relaxed that the petitioner is ordered to appear before the trial Court on the first working day of March, June, September and December at 10.30 a.m., and the other condition remains unchanged.
