2. This Court on 29.09.2021, the condition imposed on the petitioner in Crl.O.P.No.12625 of 2021, was modified that the petitioner should deposit a sum of Rs.75,000/- to the District Collector, Perambalur.



3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent submits that the above stated condition was not complied by the petitioner.

4. The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner states due to COVID situation he could not able to comply with the condition within a time stipulate by this Court.

5. Taking note of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, for depositing a sum of Rs.75,000/- [Rupees Seventy Five Thousand only] time is extended till 14.03.2022, with a condition that no further extension of time will be granted failing which, the anticipatory bail granted will be automatically cancelled without any reference to this Court.
