COMMON ORDER

The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the writ petitioners had died and she is unable to contact the legal heirs.



2. Since the applications for substitution of the legal heirs have not been filed, the Writ Petitions stand dismissed as abated. However, if the legal heirs of the deceased petitioners/workmen are of the view that the cause of action in the present writ petitions still survive, they are granted liberty to file fresh writ petitions within a reasonable time.
