W.P.No.27112 of 2021: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus forbearing the Respondents 7 and 8 and/or through their agents / associates from transferring or utilising or transacting of the funds from St. George's Anglo Indian School and Orphanage or from any other account linked to the St. George's Anglo Indian School and Orphanage or college in the absence of a duly appointed receiver by the Hon'ble Court; and directing the respondents 1-6 to conduct an enquiry and submit a report into the various instances of misappropriation of funds by the Respondents 7 and 8 and take appropriate legal action against them and the erring officials and recompense the St. George's Anglo Indian School and Orphanage all the amounts misappropriated.
