This petition is filed to condone the delay of 1376 days in re-presenting the above appeal in C.M.A.No.(SR).37913 of 2018.

2.The reasons which have been given in the affidavit filed in support of this petition is that the appellant had lost his source of income as the vehicle, namely, Mahendra Maximo, had been completely damaged and his livelihood had been badly hit and therefore, he could not mobilise the funds to make the mandatory deposit.
