PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest for the alleged offence under Section 4(1)(g) 4(1) (aaa) of TNP.Act in Cr.No.51 of 2022, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner was found in illegal possession of 110 litres of ID Arrack. Hence, the respondent police registered a case against the petitioner.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not committed any such offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence prays for grant of anticipatory bail.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submits that there are some previous cases pending as against the petitioner. Hence, he vehemently opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.



5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also the considering the fact that there are some previous cases pending as against the petitioner, this court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

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6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
