4.When the matter is taken up for hearing today, Mr.A.Gokulakrishnan, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the 1st Respondent would submit that there appears to be a dispute pending between the Petitioner's predecessor in title and the 2nd Respondent with regard to the properties concerned. He would further submit that it is beyond the jurisdiction of the first respondent to venture into a civil dispute between the parties. However, in the event of breach of peace or infraction of law and order, the first respondent will conduct enquiry and take appropriate action.



5. Recording the same, these Petitions are disposed of, with a direction to the Respondent police to complete the enquiry within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
