It is now brought to the notice of this Court by the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents 1 and 2 that subsequent to the filing of the writ petition, final orders have been passed in the impugned proceedings on 28.04.2022 therefore, nothing survives for further adjudication in this writ petition. The final order dated 28.04.2022 passed by the second respondent is also placed before this Court by the learned Government Advocate. As seen from the final order, the same has also been communicated to the petitioner. A copy of the same has also been given to the learned counsel for the petitioner in the open Court, today by the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents 1 and 2.
