PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences under sections 294(b), 324, 307 and 506(ii) of I.P.C, in Crime No.75 of 2022 seek anticipatory bail.
