



4. This Court is of the view that the defacto complainant who has arranged and paid the money is also liable to be prosecuted for getting Government Job by paying money and further the Prevention of Corruption Act amended in the year 2018, does not come in protection to bribe giver as it was in the previous version of Prevention of Corruption Act.

5. Therefore the respondent police should be aware of the law and take necessary action against the defacto complainant who admits that he has paid money to secure public office/Government Jobs.

6. In view of the above submissions, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.
