There is a delay of 757 days in paying the deficit Court fee of Rs.4,250/-.

2.Though, the petitioners have satisfactorily explained the reasons for the delay in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, since the delay is on the higher side, the same can be condoned on payment of costs. Accordingly, the delay of 757 days in paying the deficit Court fee is condoned on condition the petitioners paying a sum of **Rs.1,000/- (Rupees one thousand only) to the Hon'ble Chief Justice Relief Fund**, within one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, failing which, it is made clear that the petition shall stand dismissed automatically without any further reference to this Court.
