ORDER

The petitioner/A2, who was arrested on 08.02.2022 for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 323, 324, 307, 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No.379 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The petitioner herein is the named accused in a case of attempt to murder wherein the victim has sustained severe head injury and the hospitalised victim was discharged from the hospital very recently. However, on considering the overtact of the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, bail is granted to the petitioner and he is ordered to be released on bail subject to the following conditions;

(a) The petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of **Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only)** with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate, Madhavaram.



(b) the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the learned Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar Card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity;

WEB COPY (c) the petitioner is directed to stay at Vellore and report before South Police Station daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders.

(d) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala** [(2005)AIR SCW 5560];

(f) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
