Prayer: Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to pay the petitioner the amount payable towards the encashment of 75 days of earned leaves, surrendered by him in the years before his retirement as admitted by the respondent, either based on his monthly wages of the respective months of surrender of those earned leaves, together with 18% interest p.a. from the respective due dates or based on the monthly wages payable on the month of his retirement, together with 18% interest from the date of his retirement, within a time frame fixed by this Court.

ORDER

By consent of both the parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

This writ petition has been filed seeking to issue a Writ of Mandamus to direct the respondent to pay the petitioner the amount payable towards the encashment of 75 days of earned leaves, surrendered by him in the years before his retirement as admitted by the respondent, either based on his monthly wages of the respective months of surrender of those earned leaves, together with interest p.a. from the respective due dates or based on the monthly wages payable on

The learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondent submitted that, the respondent fairly accepted the fact that the respondent Corporation have not settled the Earned Leave encashment benefits to the petitioner. However, he would submit that if the representation of the petitioner was received, the same will be considered by the respondent Corporation and appropriate orders will be passed in accordance with law.

7. With the above directions, the writ petition is disposed of at the admission stage itself. No costs.
