PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 417, 376 and 506(i) of IPC in Crime No.02 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The petitioners are A2 to A4 in a case registered on the complaint given by one Vaitheeswari alleging that A1 Dharman promised to marry her and had sexual intercourse and later cheated her. When she questioned the same, the other accused with the petitioners herein, abused her with filthy language and threatened her with dire consequences. Hence, the complaint.

3. Heard both sides.

4. Considering the nature of the complaint where custodial interrogation is not required and only cooperation of the petitioners for the investigation is sufficient, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners on certain conditions.



5. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, within a period of seven days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court, Thirukoilur, on condition that the petitioners shall execute separate bonds for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) each, with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

(a) if the petitioners failed to surrender before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 7 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, this order shall stand automatically cancelled;

(b) the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Court concerned may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(c) the petitioners shall report before the Investigation Officer as and when required.

(d) the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(e) the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(f) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and

(g) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
