ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested on 30.01.2022 for the offences punishable under Sections 4(1)(A), 4[1](a) T.N.P.Act of IPC in Crime No.48 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The petitioner, who is a habitual offender in the prohibition offence was arrested on 30.01.2022 with possession of 10 litres of I.D. Arrack smelling poisonous odour.

3.Learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent is not in a position to say as to whether the sample sent for chemical analysis or not.



4. Considering the period of incarceration, bail is granted to the petitioner and he is ordered to be released on bail subject to the following conditions;

(a) The petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Sankarapuram.

(b) the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the learned Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar Card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity;

(c) the petitioner is directed to stay at Tiruvannamalai and report before Tiruvannamalai Town Police daily at 10.30 a.m. for a period of 30 days.

(d) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560];

(f) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
