Since this Court does not want to stand in the way of relief, if any, to the petitioner, liberty is granted to R2 to consider and dispose the representation of the petitioner dated 13.03.2022 in accordance with law and all applicable Rules and Regulations, even pending Writ Petition."

2. The learned counsel for R-1 states that pursuant to order dated 15.03.2022, the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed by the second respondent.

3. With this, and as the purpose of the writ petition stands achieved, and the same is closed. No costs.
