This is a petition to relax the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.10750 of 2019 in Crl.A.No.490 of 2019 on 05.09.2019. In and by which condition, the petitioner was directed to appear before XI Additional Special Court for CBI Cases once in every three months.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is aged about 80 years, he is suffering from chronic Heart ailment and other chronic ailments associated with the age. Hence, he finds it difficult to comply with the condition.



3. Learned Special Public Prosecutor for CBI Cases appearing for the respondent concedes that the petitioner is regularly complying with the condition.

4. Considering the fact that the petitioner is aged about 80 years and that he claims to have Heart ailment and other disease associated with the age, this Court is inclined to relax the condition totally. Accordingly, this petition stands allowed.
