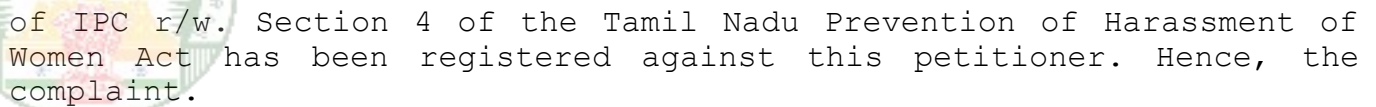

PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences under **Sections 147, 294(b), 448 and 506(II) of IPC r/w. Section 4 of the T.N.P.H.W. Act** in Crime No.527 of 2021, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The petitioners are the staff of the financial institution who had gone to the defacto complainant's house in connection with the collection of the loan amount which was defaulted by the *de facto* complainant, in the course of the process of recovery, quarrel was erupted and the present complaint has been filed alleging that the petitioners along with others came to the house of the *de facto* complainant on 28.10.2020 and abused him badly and misbehaved with the lady members of the family, one among them tried to attack and the case has been registered under Sections 147, 294(b), 448 and 506(II)



4. This Court, after perusal of the FIR, it is a case and counter and further custody interrogation of the petitioners is not required, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

(a) the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Court concerned may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(c) the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance



with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]**; and;

(f) if the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
