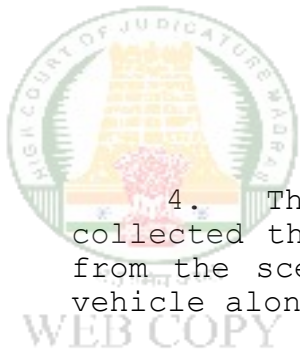
PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under sections 6(4) of TNSC (RDCS) Order 1982 r/w. 7(1)(a)(ii) of E.C.Act, 1955 in Crime No.40 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner herein illegally transported 1050 kgs of PDS rice, without any valid permit. It is further alleged that after seeing the riding party, the petitioner herein has abandoned the vehicle along with the PDS rice.

3. The learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any such offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence, he pleads for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.



4. The investigation reveals that, it was a petitioner who collected the PDS rice and on seeing the riding party, he had fled from the scene of crime at the point of seizure and abandoned the vehicle along with the PDS rice.

5. In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
