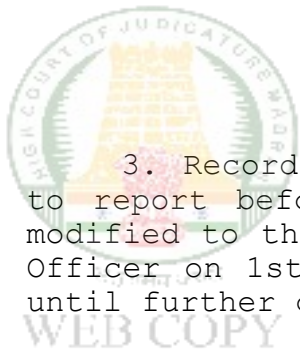

This petition has been filed to relax the conditions imposed in Crl.OP.No.1311 of 2022 dated 24.01.2022.

2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police has submitted that the investigation is not yet completed, hence, the petition for relaxation is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall report before the Investigation Officer twice in a month instead of every Saturday at 10.30 a.m.



3. Recording the same, the conditions imposed on the petitioner to report before the Investigating Officer on every Saturday is modified to the effect that he should report before the Investigating Officer on 1st and 15th working day of every month at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.
