Mr.A.Abdul Ravoof, learned counsel representing the counsel on record for for applicant is before this Court.

2. Captioned application is for 'condonation of delay' ['COD'] of 888 days in filing the Form No.66 which is for a claim.

3. Adverting to the support affidavit, learned counsel for applicant submits that the applicant had difficulty in getting to know about the winding up proceedings.
