The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 324 & 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No. 156 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. These petitioners are named persons in the First Information Report wherein the defacto complainant alleged that they came to her house along with two others, attacked her. The petitioners have sustained injury near her eye causing disruptive vision and she was treated for the said injury.



3. Considering the overt act attributed by these petitioners in the complaint and their absconding has staled the investigation, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, hence this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
