This petition has been filed seeking for exemption from surrendering before the Trial Court pursuant to the conviction and sentence imposed against the petitioner being confirmed by the appellate Court.

2. Taking into consideration the materials available on record and the grounds raised by the petitioner, this petition is allowed subject to the following conditions.

"The petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) to the credit of S.T.C.No.214 of 2016 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Fast Track Court (Magisterial Level), Ambattur, Chennai, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. If the amount is not deposited within the time stipulated by this Court, it is left open the Judicial Magistrate to issue a Non-Bailable Warrant against the petitioner and secure him to undergo the sentence imposed by the Trial Court and confirmed by the Appellate Court."



3. This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is disposed of accordingly.
