PRAYER : Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to permit the petitioner to quarry and transport the quarried mineral on payment of necessary seigniorage from the lease granted government stone quarry, measuring 5.00.0 hec. in S.F. Nos.560 & 563 (Part-6) of Nagamangalam Village, Denkanikottai Taluk, Krishnagiri District for a period of five years and five months from the date of expiry of lease period mentioned in the lease agreement i.e. from 01.07.2018 or from the date of permitting the quarry operations.
