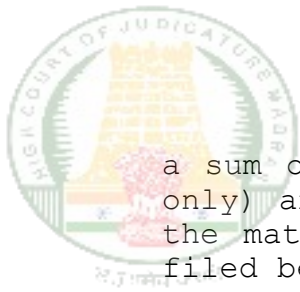

O R D E R

This Criminal Revision Case has been preferred, challenging the judgment, dated 16.12.2015 passed in C.A.No.43 of 2013 by the III Additional District and Sessions Judge, Coimbatore modifying the conviction and sentence passed against the petitioner by the Judicial Magistrate, Mettupalayam dated 14.02.2013 in C.C.No.51 of 2009.

2.Today, when the case was taken up for hearing, the learned counsels appearing on behalf of the petitioner as well as the respondent appeared before this Court, through virtual mode. The learned counsel for the petitioner made a submission that the dispute between the parties has been settled out of Court. He also filed a Joint Compromise Memo, dated 22.01.2022 before this Court to that effect.

3.The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent/ complainant is also present and he admitted that he has received



a sum of Rs.3,25,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Twenty Five Thousand only) and also made a submission that he does not want to pursue the matter further. The Joint Compromise Memo, dated 22.01.2022 filed before this Court, shall form part of this order.
