PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest for the alleged offences under Section 366(A) of IPC altered with 366 of IPC and Section 5(1), 6 and 17 of POCSO Act, in Crime No.369 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners' son and the defacto complainant loved each other. The mother of the defacto complainant has lodged a complaint on 22.06.2021 that her second daughter is missing from 20.05.2021. Hence, the defacto complainant preferred a complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent persons and they are in no way connected with the offence as alleged by the prosecution. Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
