Captioned application has been filed with a 'Condonation of Delay' ['COD'] prayer.

2. COD prayer is qua delay in filing claim petition in Form No.66.

3. Mr.S.Gopinathan, learned counsel for applicant adverting to support affidavit submits that the applicant was taking treatment for cervical problem and the intervening 'Coronavirus pandemic and consequent lock down' (collectively 'Covid 19' for clarity and brevity) was also an impediment.
