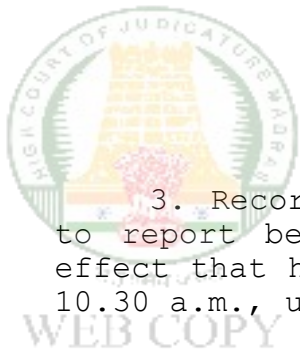

The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police has submitted that the investigation is not yet completed, hence, the petition for relaxation is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall report before the investigating Officer daily instead of Investigating Officer, Mayavaram Police Station daily at 10.30 a.m.



3. Recording the same, the conditions imposed on the petitioner to report before the Mayavaram Police Station, is modified to the effect that he shall report before the Investigating Officer daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.
