PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest for the alleged offence **under Sections 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(II) of IPC** in Crime No.118 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The petitioners have gone to the *de facto* complainant's house with a wooden log and caused injury to the *de facto* complainant all over the body particularly fractured on his right wrist and lacerated wound on right side of the head, this has occurred in connection with the quarrel between the *de facto* complainant and the petitioners herein regarding elopement of A-1's daughter with brother-in-law of the *de facto* complainant.

3. Taking note of the fact that after causing injury to the *de facto* complainant these petitioners absconded and if they granted anticipatory bail there is every possibility of abscondance and tampering of evidence.



In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
