PRAYER: Criminal Original Petition has been filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C praying to enlarge the petitioner on bail in Crime No.234 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police.

O R D E R

The petitioner, who was arrested on 15.03.2022 for the alleged offences under Sections 386, 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No.234 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The petitioner herein, aged 19 years old boy has been arrayed as A3 in a case of extortion.

3.Learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent states that the money was recovered from this petitioner and the petitioner was arrested on 15.03.2022.

4.Considering the fact that the petitioner is hardly 19 years old boy, being the first time offender, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to the following conditions;



(a) the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned XIII Metropolitan Magistrate Court, Egmore, Chennai-08;

(b) the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the learned Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar Card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity;

(c) the petitioner is directed to report before the Investigating Officer daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders.

(d) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560];

(f) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
