The petitioners are the legal heirs of the respondent in Second Appeal No.1341 of 2001. The sole respondent had died on 12.03.2014. However, the said death was not informed to the appellant and to the counsel for the respondent. Hence, the Court was not informed with regard to the death of the sole respondent and order was passed. Hence, the present miscellaneous petition is filed to grant leave.
