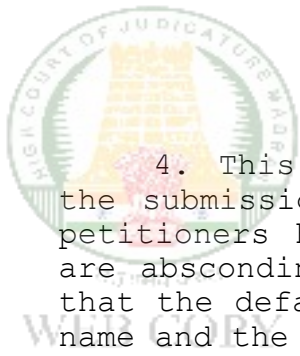




4. This Court after careful reading of both the complaint and the submission made by the counsels on either sides finds that the petitioners herein has attacked the de facto complainant and others are absconding and has given counter complaint to the DSP alleging that the defacto complainant has abused the petitioners using caste name and the same is registered in Crime No.57 of 2022.

5. Considering the nature of weapon used and circumstances under which the occurrence has taken place, this Court finds that it is not a fit case for granting anticipatory bail and if anticipatory bail is granted there may be recurrence of the crime. Hence, petition for anticipatory bail is dismissed.
