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The order impugned dated 18.12.2015 reveals that the petitioner submitted an application for the Educational Loan of Rs.3.83 Lakhs to pursue MBA course at Vels University. The respondent bank informed that as per the Scheme, the eligible tuition fees for the course is Rs.72,000 only and therefore, the bank requested the petitioner to produce the source for the remaining sum i.e. Rs.3.11 Lakhs in order to enable them to proceed further.

2. The petitioner is under the challenge of the year 2015. Now, nearly five and half years lapsed and the course itself has expired. Hence, the relief sought for in the present writ petition has lost its relevance. If any other grievance exists for the petitioner, it is left open to the petitioner to approach the competent authorities for the purpose of redressal of his grievances in the manner known to law.

3. With this observation, the writ petition stands closed. No costs.
