PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest for the alleged offence under Sections 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(II) of IPC in Crime No.81 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The petitioner herein is a 18 years old boy who has attacked the de facto complainant with a wooden log and caused fractured injury to him.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that due to land and pathway dispute, there was previous enmity between the de facto complainant and the petitioner's family and on the date of occurrence, the de facto complainant attacked the mother of the petitioner herein and this petitioner along with his mother and father went to question the de facto complainant, infuriated by that, a false complaint has been given. He would further submit that there is a case and counter case registered against the de facto complainant for the offence under Sections 294(b), 323 of IPC and Section 4 of the Women Harassment Act.
