The petitioner challenges the impugned order of detention in C3/D.O.No.20/2022 dated 11.04.2022, detaining her husband as "Black Marketeer" as contemplated under the provision of Prevention of Black Marketing and Maintenance of Supplies of Essential Commodities Act, 1980 (Central Act 7 of 1980).
